Some of the many things that you might want to do musically include:

- Change the rhythm (use syncopation)
- Change the harmony (try 7th chords, use secondary chords)
- Change the modality (major vs. minor)
- Add notes to the melody (scales, neighboring tones, embellishments)
- Add little interruptions (if it fits the mood)
- There are many, many more things you can do! These are just suggestions!
