Students who do not know the Major/minor chord by site can count the half steps between the root and the 3<sup>rd</sup> of the chord. There are 4 half steps in a Major chord and 3 half steps in a minor chord.

### **Printing Tips**

These flashcards are designed to be printed on 3.5 x 5 inch index cards. However, if you use 4 x 6 cards, the printing will still be centered. Please run a test copy of a single page before attempting to print all pages onto index cards.

Most printers will respond best if you use the manual feed to print these cards.


If your printer does not accept the 3.5 x 5 or 4 x 6 inch cards, then you may also print them onto regular sized paper.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> document (called Major minor chords BACK) contains the name of the triad if you would like to print the answers to the backs of these cards.


